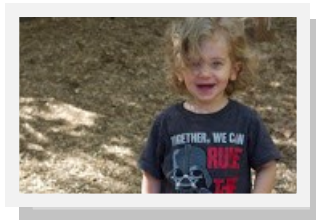
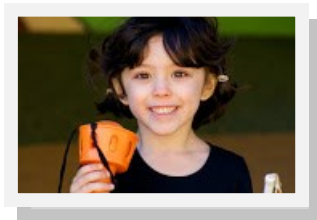
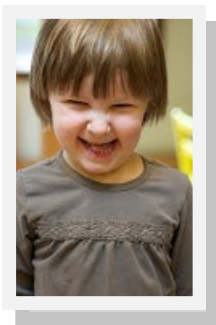
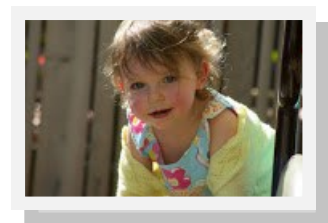
Access to Photos and Video
